This special issue aims to present cutting-edge research in molecular spectroscopy, including molecular structure, dynamics, and interactions; methodological advances and developments; bio-spectroscopy; applications of artificial intelligence, chemometrics, and theory; dielectric spectroscopy; and applied spectroscopy. I would be delighted if you would accept our invitation to develop an article for this issue. The submission deadline is 28 February 2026. You can read the full special issue scope [here](#). Additionally, it's free to publish your paper to publish with standard subscription agreements.

It's also worth noting here that we are planning for a fast publication process for this special issue: the aim is to provide a first decision on articles within 12 days following submission, and the special issue will be published on ScienceDirect. Your article will also be promoted by the journal to ensure our community sees it and cites it! Finally, I think it is important to add that articles published in special issues are often cited more frequently than articles published in regular issues, especially when published in journals like *Journal of Molecular Structure*.
